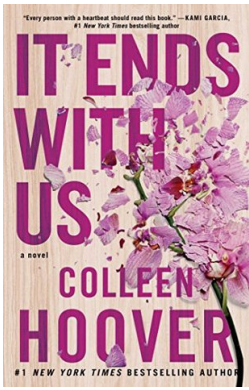


It Ends With Us by Colleen Hoover

- What's your opinion about the portrayal of domestic violence in the book?

- Do you think reading It Ends With Us has changed your perspective on domestic violence or relationships in general? Why or Why Not?
- What are your thoughts about the representation of mental health issues in the book?
- How did the narrative structure of It Ends With Us influence your perception of Lily's character?
- 'You are my wife. I'm supposed to be the one who protects you from the monsters. I'm not supposed to be one, how do you interpret Ryle's statement in the context of their relationship and throughout the story?
- What do you think about Lily's relationship with her father?
